- ★ English 10 First Peoples is the academic equivalent of English Language Arts 10.
- ★ English 11 First Peoples is the academic equivalent of English Language Arts 11.
- ★ English 10 & 11 First Peoples enable students to develop the English language and literacy skills and capacities they must have in order to meet B.C.'s graduation requirements.
