All children born in 2007 are eligible to begin Kindergarten in September.

To register, please bring:

- Proof of your child's age and citizenship status (birth certificate, passport, landed immigrant authorization). Parents of children who **are not** Canadian Citizens or Landed Immigrants must phone 250-592-6871 prior to registering.
- Proof of your address (driver's licence, utility bill, etc.)
- Your child's BC Care Card
- **Register January 30 to February 3, 2012 at your catchment area school.**

To request an out-of-catchment school within the District, register at your catchment school and complete a Student Transfer Form.
