Route 1: Grenville

Begins at the top of Grenville Ave at 8:00am. It continues down Grenville to Effingham at 8:10am. It turns left on Esquimalt Rd to Fraser St. It crosses Esquimalt Rd and Fraser at 8:17am. It continues on Fraser and stops in front of the Rec Centre at 8:20. It stops at Fraser and Lyall at 8:25am. It continues along Lyall Street to the back field at Macaulay school.

Route 2: Lyall Street

Begins at the corner of Grafton and Lyall at 8:10am; Foster at 8:12, Sturdee 8:14, Nelson 8:16, Constance 8:18, Admirals 8:20, Fraser 8:23, arrive opposite the parking lot at Archie Browning Sports Centre at 8:25am. This parking lot is a great place to park your car and join the walking group. It will then carry on down Lyall until it reaches the back field of Macaulay school.

Route 3: Lampson Street

Begins at the corner of Lampson St and Old Esquimalt Rd. This group will leave at 8:10am and walk down Lampson St stopping at Fernhill at 8:15 and Norma Court at 8:20am. They will cross Esquimalt Rd at 8:25. Then proceed down Lampson to Wollaston 8:30, Dunsmuir 8:33 and the corner of Lampson and Lyall for 8:35. Route 4: Macaulay Point
