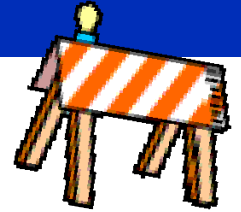

Energy Efficient Windows

The process to install new Energy Efficient Windows in the main wing of the building has begun. District Staff will be on site over the upcoming weeks removing the old single pane windows from rooms on the ground and second floors and replacing them with new Energy Efficient windows. It will take from 2-3 days to complete the windows for each room. During this time, classes will be moved to a temporary classroom that will be set up in the current Aboriginal Education room on the bottom floor of the school. Please use caution in the areas in which the workers are working and if you have any questions please feel free to ask.
