POSITION DESCRIPTION Heating - Mechanic

The Heating Mechanic reports to the Department Foreman. The Heating Mechanic performs heating mechanic duties as assigned and may be required to assist the mechanical department as needed.

HM – 1

Responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of gas boiler plant installations as well as hot water and forced air systems and all types of heating control systems (i.e. pneumatic, electronic and digital, etc.).

HM – 2

Diagnoses problems and/or failures in heating systems for the purpose of identifying repair and replacement needs necessary to maintain equipment and systems.

HM – 3

Monitors boiler heating systems for the purpose of ensuring compliance with established safety regulations and/or operation within District, and site, established parameters.

HM – 4

Repairs systems and components (e.g. pumps, seals, bearings, impellers, belts, motors, steam coils, valves, electronic devices, etc.) for the purpose of ensuring safety and efficiency of machinery. Repairs, installs, alters and maintains electronic and pneumatic control systems.

HM – 5

Responds to emergency situations for the purpose of resolving immediate safety concerns.

HM - 6

Works independently, and when required, travels from job site to job site using either a School Board or privately owned vehicle for transporting workers, supplies, materials, tools and/or equipment to the sites.

HM - 7

Repairs and maintains heating systems, including hot water pumps, motors, fans and their associated controls.

HM - 8

Reads and interprets drawings and specifications, orders materials and supplies, lays out projects and reports on work in progress as required.

HM – 9

Tests water and chemical levels for the purpose of maintaining anticorrosion chemicals within closed-loop systems for preventative maintenance purposes.

HM – 10

Assists and liaises with employees, contractors, regulatory agencies and other trades as required.

HM- 11

Performs other related duties as related to the above.
