## POSITION DESCRIPTION

### Painter

#### **PA - 1**

Responsible to the appropriate supervisor through the assigned foreman and/or charge hand painter.

#### **PA - 2**

Performs interior and exterior painting and decorating as assigned.

#### **PA - 3**

Prepares all surfaces for painting by using any of the following methods: paint removers, scrapers, wire brushes, sanders, blow torches, sand blasting, etc.

#### **PA - 4**

Fills holes, crevices and cracks and seals joints with putty, caulking and other filler.

#### **PA - 5**

Prepares and mixes paints and finishes as required.

#### **PA - 6**

Applies paints, lacquers, stains, varnishes and finishes, etc. using brushes, rollers, spray equipment and applicators.

#### **PA - 7**

Installs interior wall coverings such as wallpaper, fabrics, etc.

#### **PA - 8**

Erects and disassembles scaffolding, ladders, etc. as required and works from same.

#### **PA - 9**

Reports promptly to the appropriate foreman or supervisor, any mechanical failures or body damage to School Board vehicles, equipment and tools.

**PA - 10**

Cleans work areas, equipment and tools.

**PA - 11**

Performs duties in compliance with safety regulations.

**PA - 12**

Performs other assigned duties related to the above.

**Note:** Where such duties related to sign painting are assigned, the incumbent is required to operate related graphic and design, manual or computerized equipment.

<b>EDUCATION</b>	<b><i>TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS</i></b>  Grade 12 certificate or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.  Valid Class 5 British Columbia Drivers License.  <b><i>OTHER RELATED COURSES</i></b>  Must possess a valid Certificate of Apprenticeship as issued or recognized by the Province of B.C. or a certificate of trade qualification as issued or recognized by the Province of B.C.
<b>EXPERIENCE</b>	<b><i>TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS</i></b>  Must have a minimum of five (5) years painting experience.

<p><b>KNOWLEDGE</b></p>	<p>THE CANDIDATE MUST POSSESS A DEMONSTRATED KNOWLEDGE OF:</p> <p>The standards, practices, methods, materials, tools and equipment used for the construction, repair and maintenance of buildings, grounds or equipment in his/her area of expertise.</p> <p>Job related safety regulations and techniques as outlined in the Workers' Compensation Board Industrial Health and Safety Regulations.</p> <p>School District #61 Policies and Regulations, Municipal, Provincial and Federal regulations relevant to his/her department.</p> <p>Sign Fabricator requires: mathematical, spelling and reading comprehension skills as related to work assignments, basic computer knowledge, artistic aptitude.</p>
<p><b>SKILLS AND ABILITIES</b></p>	<p><b><i>THE CANDIDATE MUST POSSESS A DEMONSTRATED ABILITY TO:</i></b></p> <p>Maintain a cooperative working relationship with other workers, administrators, supervisors, teaching staff, students and the public.</p> <p>Adapt to changing circumstances and the flexibility to adapt plans and schedules to meet unforeseen circumstances.</p> <p>Read and interpret plans and specifications.</p> <p>Understand and carry out written and oral instructions.</p> <p>Perform duties in compliance with safety regulations.</p>
