REGULATION 6164.1

SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES

The Capital Regional Community Health Department shall be expected to carry out the following services:

- 1. Carry out testing of vision and hearing of school students at various levels.
- 2. Carry out physical examinations of students and/or staff as required.
- 3. Carry out, on a regular basis, inspections of facilities and, where appropriate, equipment.
- 4. Advise on the needs for school health facilities.
- 5. Advise on levels of lighting and noise.
- 6. Advise on psychological or psychiatric referrals of students and/or staff.
- 7. Advise and participate in family life programs.
- 8. Advise and participate in nutrition programs.
- 9. Advise on first aid requirements facilities, equipment, materials.
- 10. Advise schools on student and/or staff medication.
- 11. Advise on learning disabilities as related to physical and mental health.
- 12. Provide schedule for tuberculosis screening of staff and students as required.

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- 13. Provide for Rubella testing of females.
- 14. Conduct on a scheduled basis immunization of students and/or staff.
- 15. In an emergency, to carry out procedures to maintain good health.
