

## **REGULATION 6165.3**

## **CONSTRUCTION PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS**

All proposed off-campus construction projects for students must first be approved by the appropriate zone assistant superintendent.

- 1. The principal, in consultation with the appropriate zone assistant superintendent, shall advertise for clients through the Community Relations office. The advertisement shall contain detailed specification and restrictions.
- 2. The restrictions shall include:
  - a) the maximum distance that the project can be from the school;
  - b) the nature of the project(s) to be considered
- 3. A committee composed of the school principal, administrative assistant or industrial education department head, construction teacher and zone assistant superintendent shall review the application and select the project(s).
- 4. The secretary-treasurer and successful applicant shall execute a proper contract for the project.
- 5. The client will pay the cost of all materials used.
- 6. The client shall pay mileage and upkeep costs of a school vehicle used to transport students to and from the site.
- 7. In selecting projects priority will be given to requests from the handicapped, senior citizens and pensioners.
- 8. No employee of the Board or school trustee shall apply for or be awarded a construction project.
