TASK 2018

Students will experience a variety of trades including carpentry, electrical, sheet metal, welding, plumbing, machining, general maintenance, installation, inspection, demolition, testing and troubleshooting.

- Dual Credit (Secondary and Post Secondary)
- An introduction to SD 61 ACEIT Programs
- Certification in WHMIS, Fall Protection and Confined Space Entry
- Skills to gain employment and/or enter an apprenticeship
- Further post secondary training
