

ABORIGINAL EDUCATION ASSISTANT (Spareboard)

The Greater Victoria School District provides public educational services to over 19,000 students in the Greater Victoria Area, encompassing five municipalities. To provide this service, the District has a current operating budget of \$184 million and employs approximately 3,000 staff; which includes, teachers, principals and vice-principals, support staff, psychologists, speech and language pathologists and exempt managerial staff.

In ten of our schools the Aboriginal Education Assistant (AEA) provides social, emotional and academic support and guidance to Aboriginal students. Additionally, as a role model and cultural interpreter, the AEA mentors Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal students in understanding Aboriginal culture.

The Aboriginal Education Assistant – Spareboard is a member of CUPE Local 947 and is paid at a rate of \$21.79 per hour plus 11% in lieu of benefits. Preference will be given to persons of Aboriginal ancestry.

You must have:

- Grade 12 or equivalent.
- One (1) year Indigenous Family Support Certificate,
 - or Community Support Worker program;
 - or equivalent post-secondary courses in child and adolescent development or behavior management.
- One (1) year specific experience working with Aboriginal students, parents and the community.
- Ability to transfer knowledge and understanding of Aboriginal culture, heritage, values and history.
