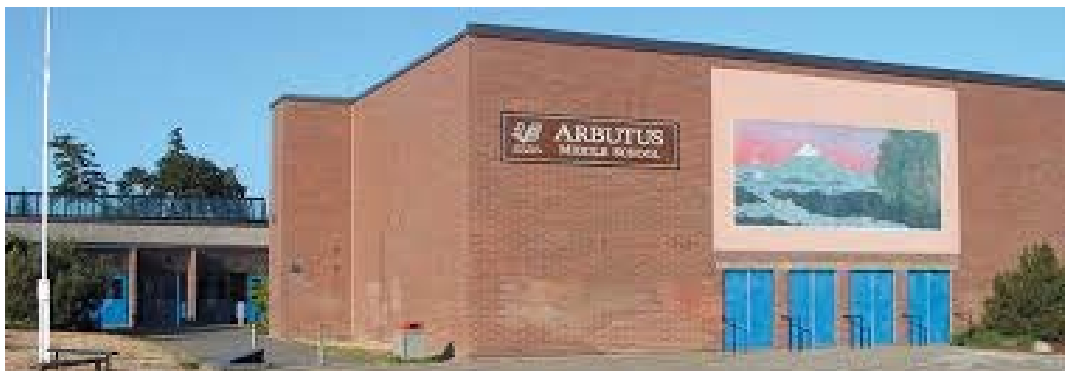


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Appendix 1 - Arbutus Middle School



School Description

The school is located at 2306 Edgelow St., Saanich, British Columbia, V8N 1R5. The single-storey building with basement was originally constructed in 1970. The school had two area additions in 1975 (595 m²) and in 1987 (14 m²) and currently has a total of 6,965 m² of floor area.

School Objectives

The goal of Arbutus Global Middle School is to provide a school-wide focus on global education, environmental awareness and social responsibility as enrichment to the established provincial curriculum for grade 6, 7, 8 students. By linking the provincial curriculum to global education initiatives such as communicating via the Internet with schools around the world, examining issues from a global perspective, holding debates on current events issues, and fundraising for both local and international groups, we teach students the skills they need to become informed, active global citizens able to consider issues from a variety of perspectives and empowered to act in order to make a difference locally and internationally.

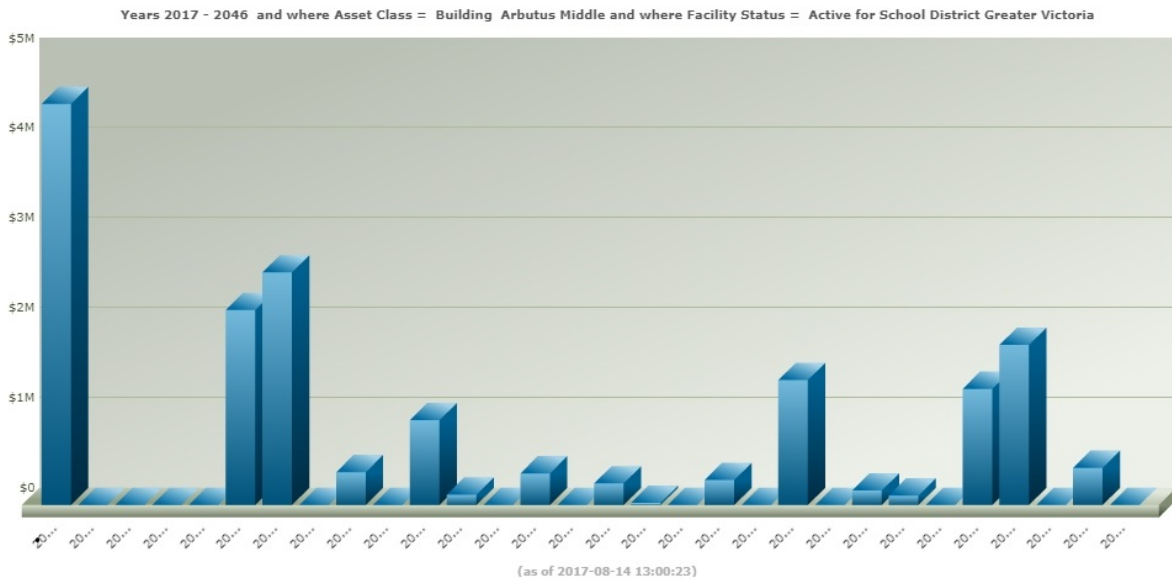

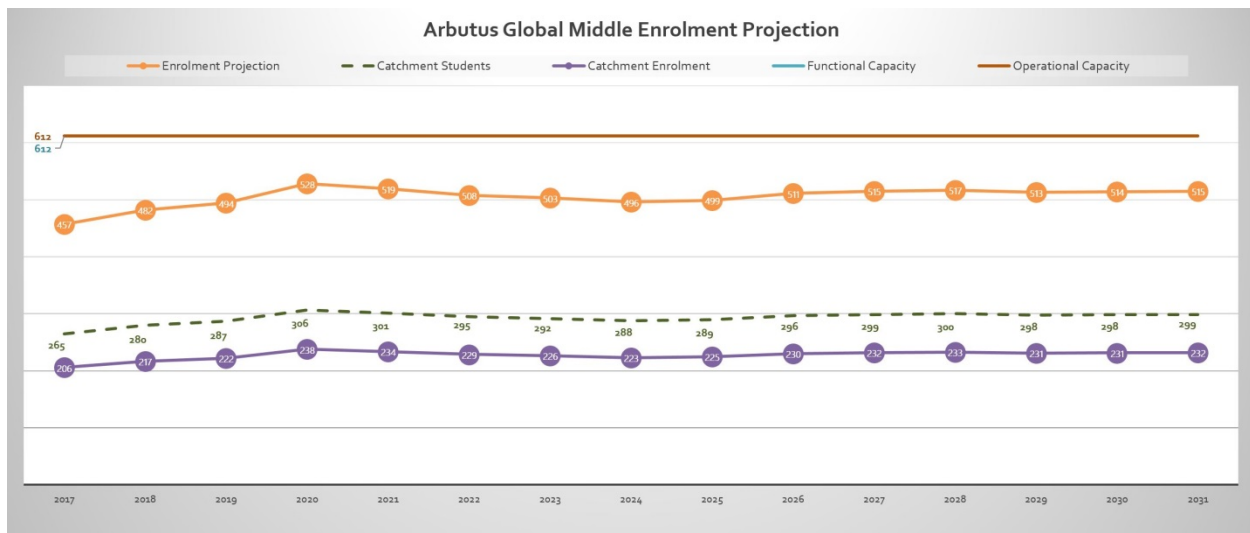

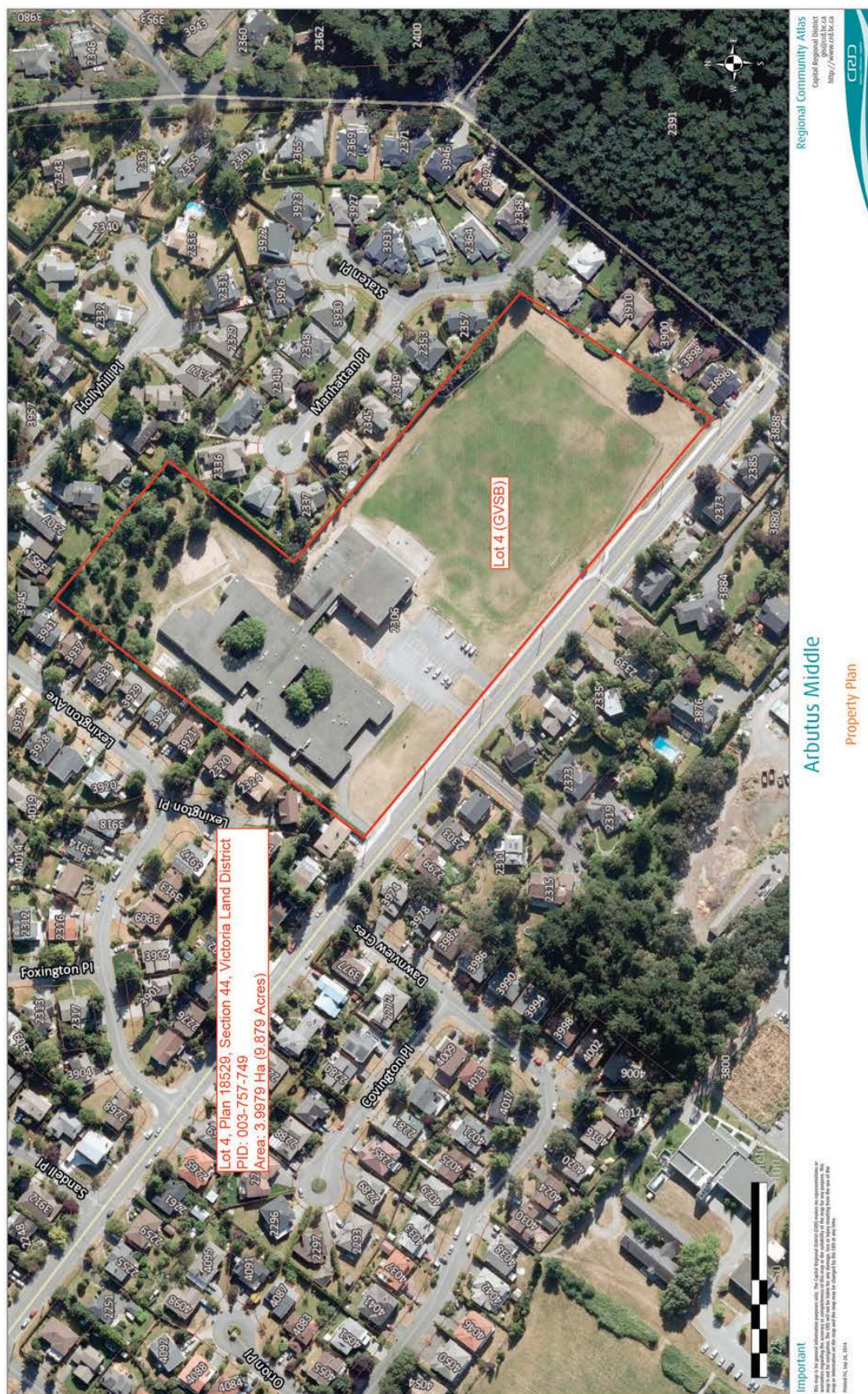

Appendix 2 - Braefoot Elementary School



School Description

Braefoot Elementary School is located adjacent to the semi-rural Blenkinsop Valley. The building was originally constructed in 1964. The school had two area additions in 1970 (2,179), and in 1971 (683 m²) and currently has a total of 3,373 m² of floor area. The two storey (1970) portion of the school building received a structural seismic upgrade in about 2002. .

School Objectives

The immediate area consists of predominantly single family homes. A wide range of ethnic backgrounds represent the student population. The school represents an exceptional K-5 model that encompasses a balanced emphasis on academics, and participation in the fine arts and athletics. This is evidenced by high standings in test scores, high participation levels in physical activities and whole school involvement in a wide variety of drama, music, and visual arts program's.

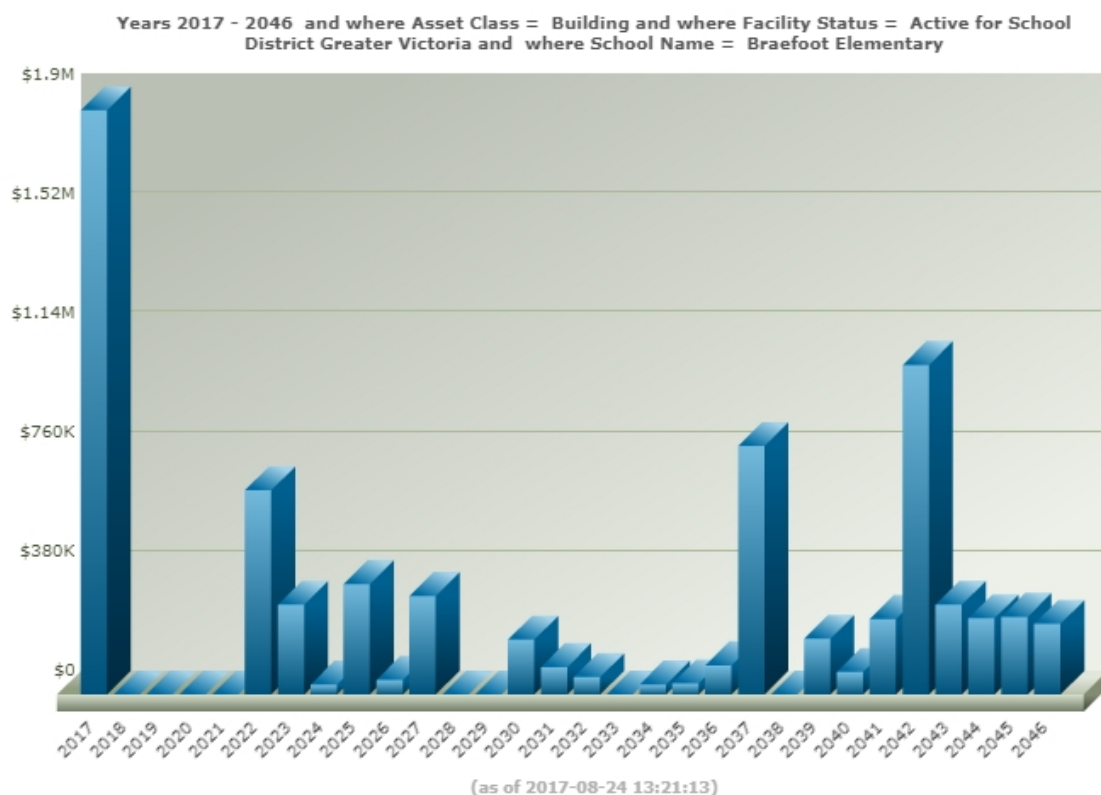

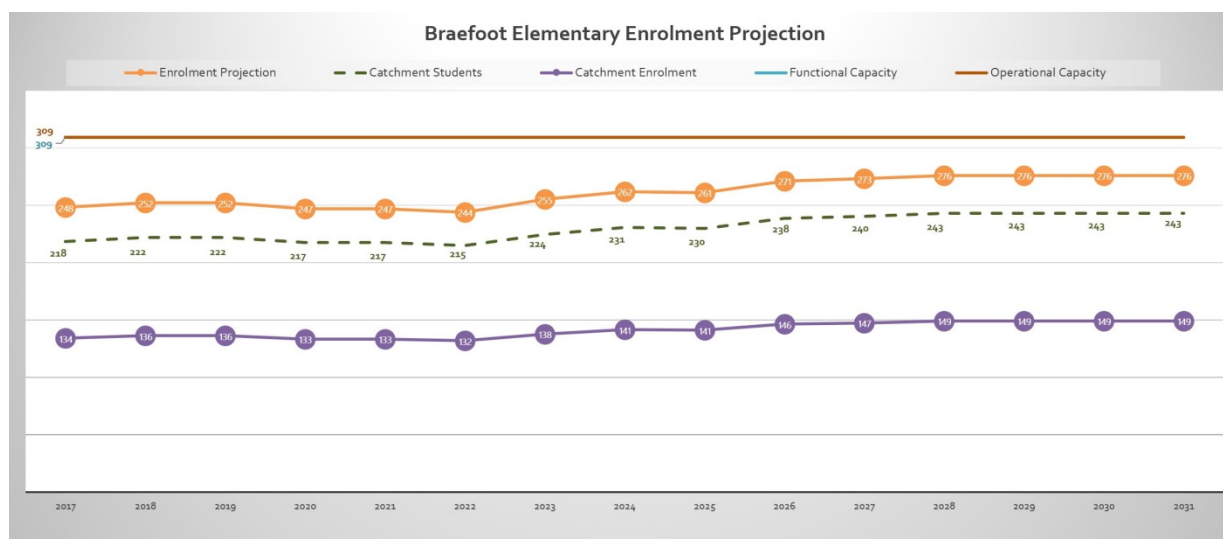

Appendix 3 - Campus View Elementary School



School Description

Campus View Elementary School is a K-5 dual track English and Early French Immersion school with a total population of approximately 460 students in 19 classroom divisions.

The single-storey building was originally constructed in 1959. The school had four area additions; in 1962 (555 m²), 1964 (741 m²), 1967 (625 m²) and in 2001 (498m²). It currently has a total of 3,376 m² of floor area.

School Objectives

The majority of our students live in the catchment areas of Gordon Head, Cadboro Bay, and North Oak Bay. With our close proximity to the University of Victoria, Campus View benefits from the expertise of university students, staff and faculty who provide supplementary programming and opportunities for our own students.

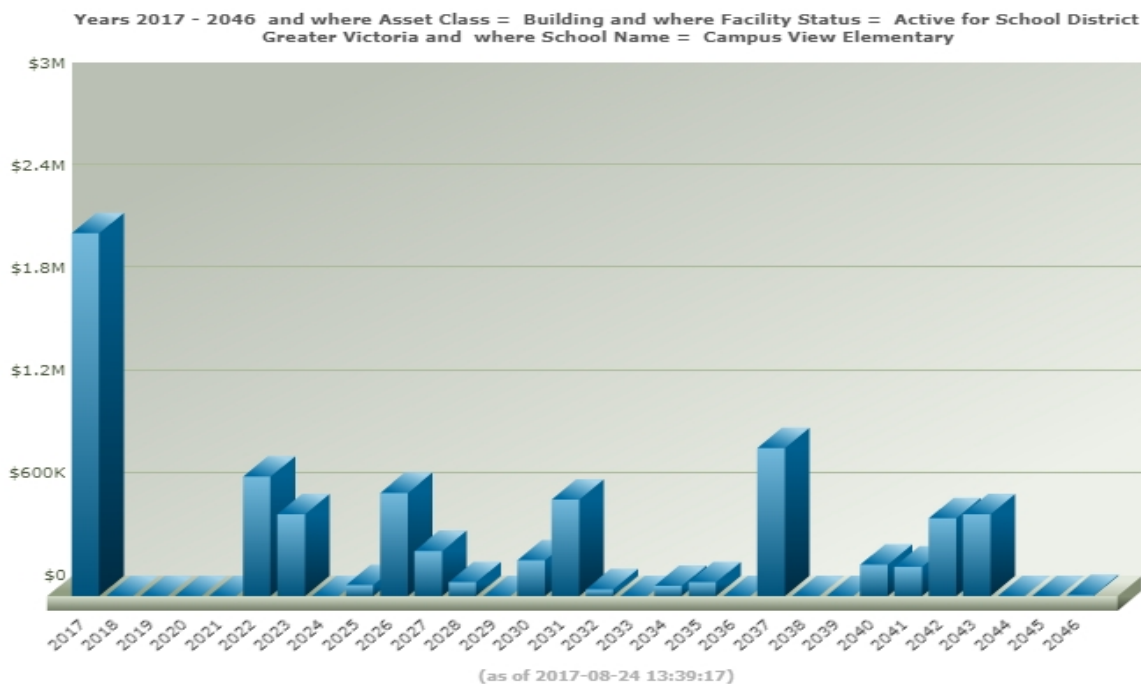

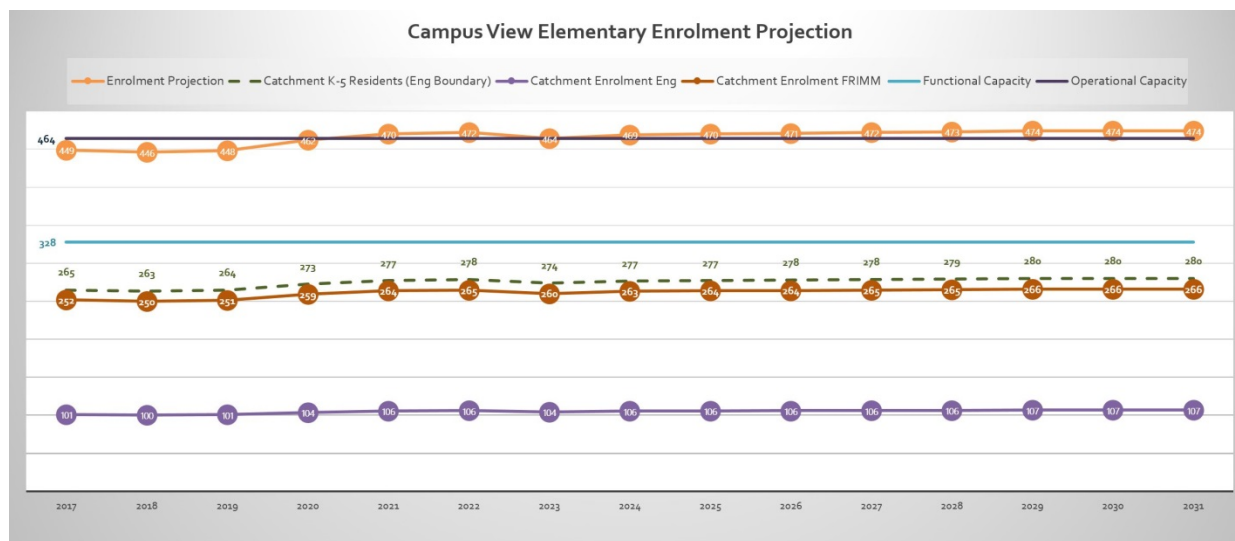

Appendix 4 - Cedar Hill Middle School



School Description

The school is located at 3910 Cedar Hill Rd., Saanich, British Columbia, V8P 3Z9. The two-storey building was originally constructed in 1931. The school had building additions in 1953, 1956, 1959, 1966, 1969, 1972 and 1975. The school currently has a total of 6,804 m² of floor area. Cedar Hill has a unique history as one of the Victoria School District's longest standing schools. It was originally the first Mount Douglas High School, before becoming Cedar Hill Junior High.

School Objectives

With a school population of about 500 students, Cedar Hill provides an inviting, supportive and safe learning culture for a diverse group of students in grades 6 to 8. They are a "Dual Track" school offering educational programs in both French and English, and are a part of the Reynolds Family of Schools. This school ensures a fully rounded, student-centered approach to education. They emphasize academic excellence; appreciation and performance in the Fine Arts; participation in athletics, games, physical fitness, and various leisure activities; and instruction in nutrition, healthy living, and social responsibility

Cedar Hill has very close ties to the surrounding community, and regularly involves their students in connecting with local Seniors Centres. They are in very close vicinity to the Nellie McClung Branch of the Greater Victoria Public Library, the University of Victoria, and Cedar Hill Recreation Centre, and they take advantage of the opportunities this provides.

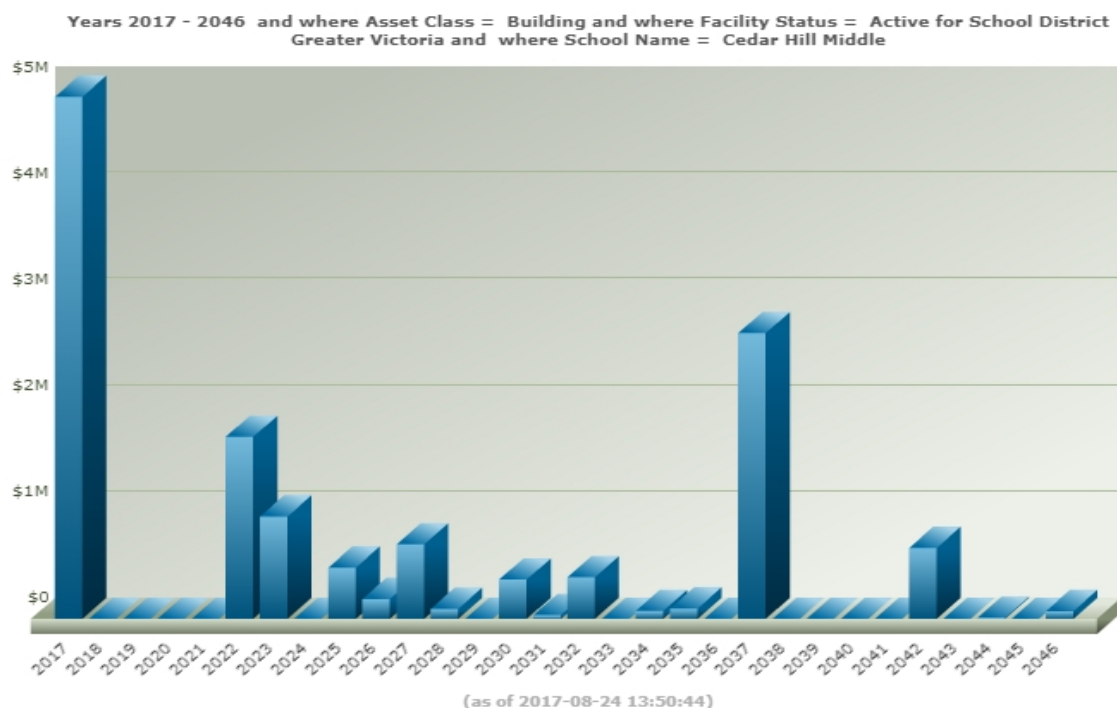

Doncaster Elementary School is a dual track French Immersion / English school in Victoria, which currently enrolls approximately 430 students from Kindergarten through Grade 5.

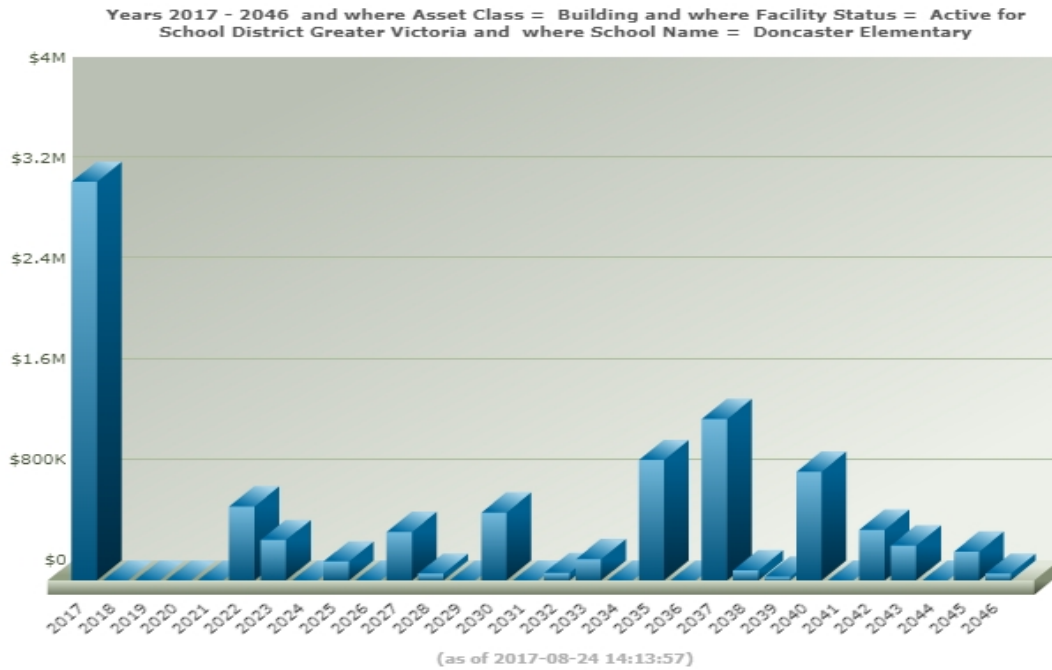

They are a school known for a focus on academic achievement, social and environmental responsibility, and participation in fine arts, sports, and fitness.

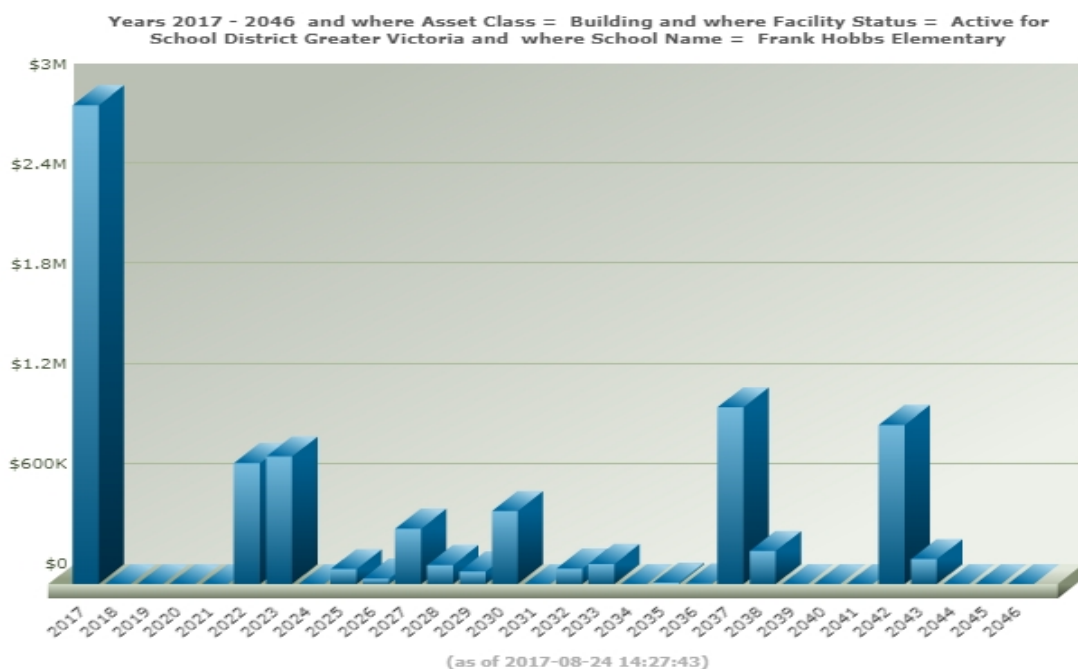

Appendix 24 - McKenzie Elementary School



School Description

The school is located at 4140 Glanford Ave Saanich British Columbia V8Z 4A8. The one-storey building with crawlspace was originally constructed in 1934. The school had area additions in 1959, 1963 (1,587 SM) and in 1971, 1972, 1977 (1,429 SM) and currently has a total of 3,994 SM of floor area. The 1963 addition received a structural seismic upgrade in 2011.

The history of McKenzie School might be divided into two parts, the division being in 1934, when fire destroyed much of the original building. The original school had a very modest beginning – a one room wooden unit built in 1912. Standing on one acre of ground, the total value of land, school and equipment was listed at \$2,500.

In 1913-1914, the population so increased that two rooms were added, making an imposing three room structure. Soon, even this addition proved inadequate, and by 1918 two more rooms were added, bringing the school to a total of five classrooms. In 1926, Mr. P. C. Routley, the school's principal, managed to get electricity installed in the school. He took a petition around the then sparsely housed section west of Seven Oaks, requesting the names of those who would be willing to start using electricity. Prior to this time, coal oil lamps were brought into the classrooms during the dark winter days.

The current “old wing” of the school was constructed on the foundation of the old structure, which was re-built after the fire in 1934. The “old gym” was completed in 1959 and in 1963 the North Wing (office wing) was added. In 1972 the Library Wing was built as an “open area”, but was soon renovated to become the four classrooms which currently are located on either side of the library.

In 1977, the new gym was constructed after a section of the 1934 school building was demolished, leaving 4 classrooms from that building which are still in use today. In June 2007,

the new gym was renamed the “Demers Gym” in memory of John Demers, a long-time parent and educational assistant who passed away in September 2006.

Since 1977, McKenzie has had minor alterations and renovations, with earthquake reinforcement taking place in 2011 and a new driveway-drop-off area completed in 2012.

In September 2004, McKenzie reconfigured to a Kindergarten to Grade 5 school, enrolling 260 students. Currently the school registers 210 students.

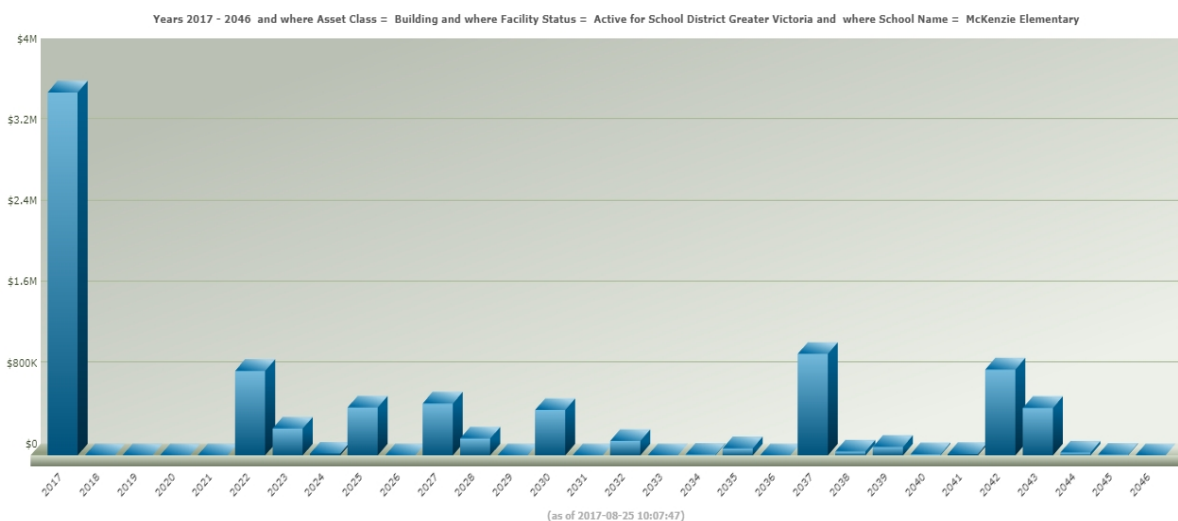

School Description

The school is located at 2827 Belmont Ave, Saanich British Columbia, V8R 4B2. The two-storey building with partial basement was originally constructed in 1913. The school had area additions completed in 1971 and 2000 and currently has a total of 4,930 SM of floor area. The school includes a community centre and child care facility. The school building received a structural seismic upgrade in about 2000.

Oaklands Elementary School is a vibrant community school that encompasses a population of approximately 460 K-5 students. The school building is organized into an intermediate area (Grades 3-5) and a primary (Areas K-3) area. Students are instructed in Fine Arts, Athletics, Core curriculum (Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies), Social Responsibility, French (Grades 4-5), and Health and Career.

Accompanying the classroom instructional program are the extra-curricular opportunities that range from chess club to noon hour soccer. In the Arts, strings, art, dance, and drama classes are presented to students each week. Guest performers visit the school on occasion to teach and entertain. Students can perform in classes, concerts, talent shows, or at other times throughout the year.

The school facility encompasses a full basketball court with a half court in a separate area. Interspersed with play areas are oak trees and rock outcrops to make for a naturally unique playground. Two adventure playgrounds keep students active and entertained at recess times, Daily Physical Activity, and during physical education. The Greening Project has resulted in grassy areas enhanced with native Victorian plants. A unique feature of the school is the courtyard where students become actively involved in seasonal plantings of the school garden.

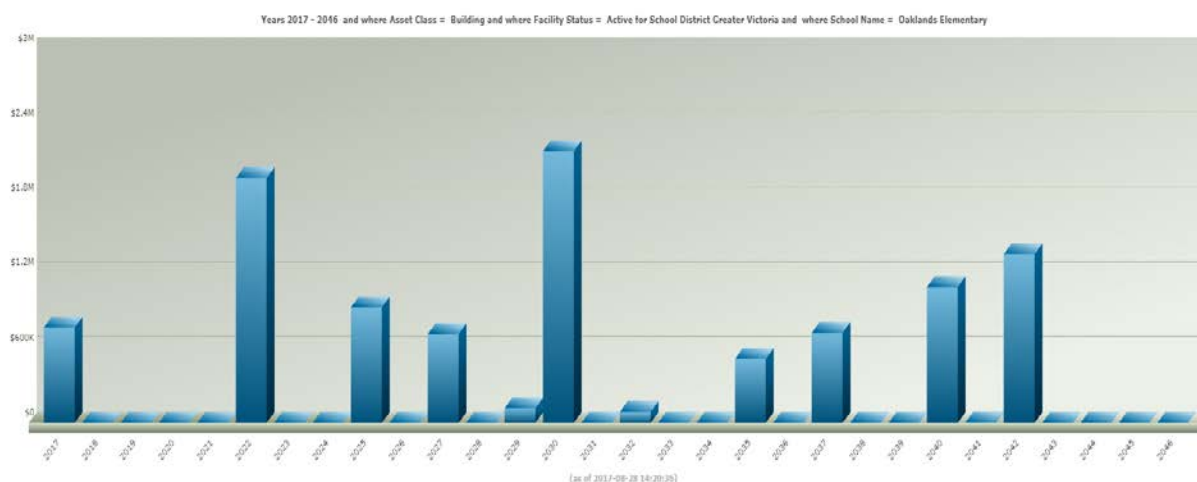

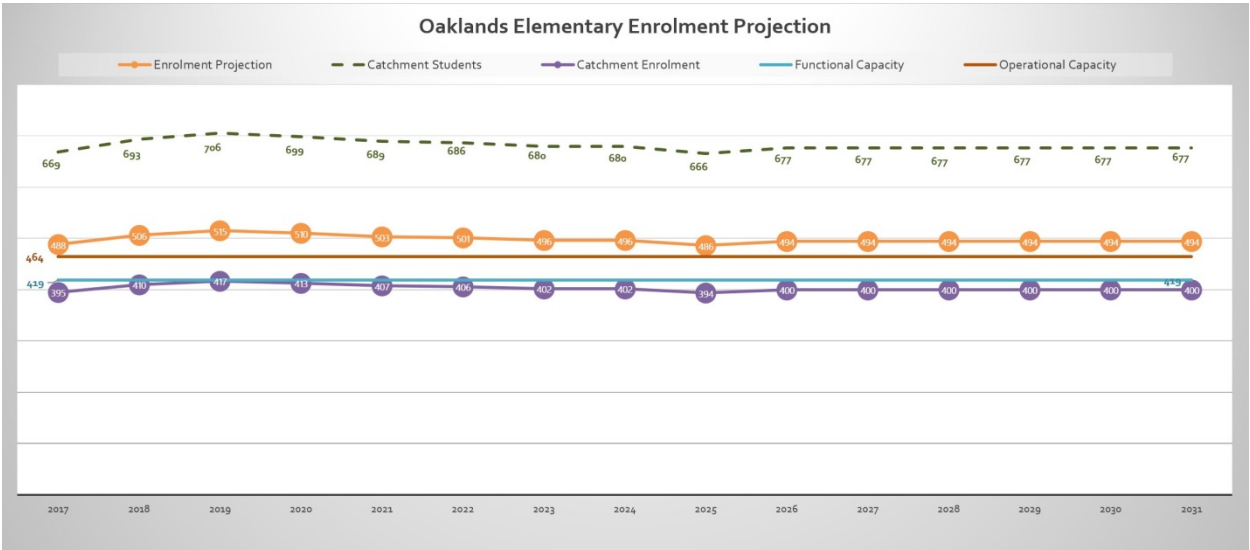

Appendix 30 - Quadra Elementary School



School Description

Quadra Elementary School is located at 3031 Quadra St., Victoria, British Columbia. The two-storey building with basement was originally constructed in 1914. The school had area additions in 1962 (706 m²), in 1968 (974 m²) and in 1974 (529 m²) and currently has a total of 4,489 m² of floor area. The school building received a major structural seismic upgrade, a new entry lobby and extensive interior renovations in 2014.

This school currently enrolls approximately 400 students in a vibrant, diverse community of Kindergarten to Grade 5. Quadra is a dual track school offering English and French curriculum.

1913 — The annex, consisting of two classrooms, was built. The school was named after Don Juan Francisco Quadra, a Spanish explorer in the coastal area in the latter part of the 18th century.

1914 — The main building, consisting of eight classrooms and an auditorium, was completed. The school had an enrollment of 181 pupils.

1916 — The annex became an Industrial Arts Center. It continued to be used in this capacity until S.J. Willis Jr. Secondary School opened in 1950.

1963 — The first addition, consisting of three classrooms, a library, and an administration area, was completed.

1967 — The second addition, consisting of a four classroom open area, was completed.

1974 — The gymnasium was completed.

1975 — The open area was converted to a library.

1979 — The French Immersion program transferred from Cloverdale school. The library was moved to its present location, which had previously been the school auditorium. The original open area became four self-contained classrooms.

1980 — Fifth street was blocked off at Finlayson and part was added to the school playground. An adventure play area was installed.

1989 — The 75th anniversary of the school was celebrated.

2003 — Quadra becomes a K–5 school.

2004 — Quadra celebrated its 90th birthday.

2013-2014 – Quadra School was seismically upgraded. Students were bused to the alternative site on Richmond Road for the school year.

2014-2015 – Quadra celebrated its 100th year: Proud Past, Strong Present and Bright Future.

2015 – In the spring, Tony Hunt Jr. carved a totem pole for Quadra Elementary to commemorate the 100th year anniversary

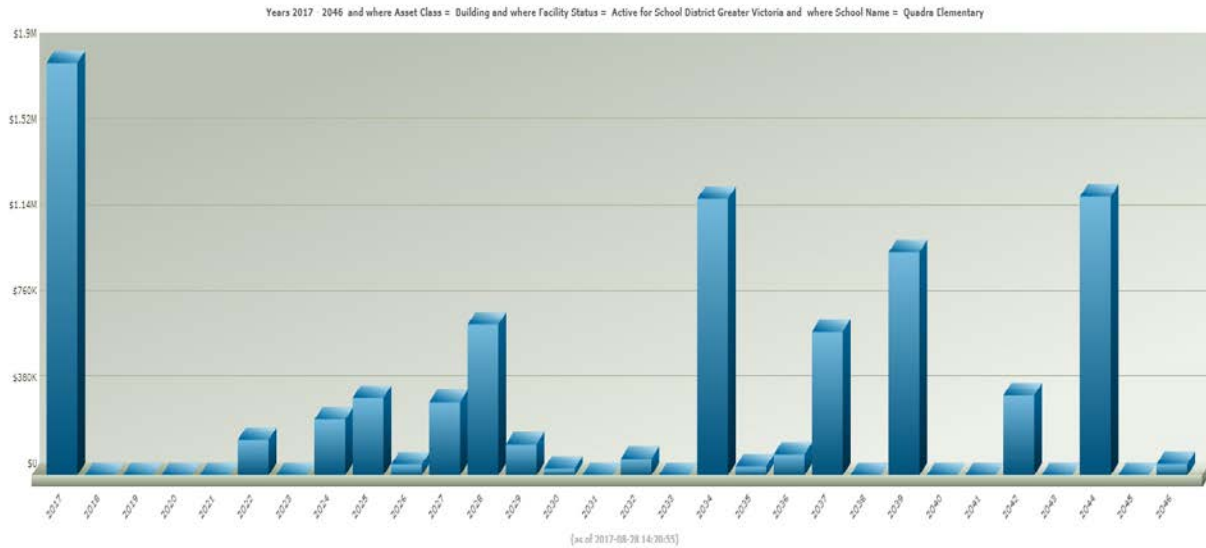

Uplands Campus is located at 3461 Henderson Road., Victoria, British Columbia, V8P 5A8. The one-storey building was originally constructed in 1958 (1,257 m²). The school had area additions in 1962 (845 m²), 1964 (325 m²) and in 1970 (36 m²). Most recently, the facility received renovations in 2010 with an updated entrance and conversion of classrooms into office space to house the International Student Program. It currently has a total of 2,463 m² of floor area.

Uplands Campus is home to the Greater Victoria School District's international student program (ISP) which hosts students, the administrative services team, the homestay program, teaching staff and the student support team (for international students). These include the Uplands Academic Transition Program (year round), Camp Victoria ELL Summer Program (July and August), and Group ELL Study Programs (year round). Uplands Campus also offers ELL classes for the parents of international students (September to June), new student orientations at Uplands Campus (year round), and the Global and Intercultural Skills Program (year round). Uplands Campus also offers a wide variety of student activities offered year round including homework club and university information sessions. The site also hosts many district professional development events and training

sessions for school district staff. Originally an elementary school, the building has been renovated to meet the needs of ELL learners with smaller classrooms suitable for 15 students. The international student program relocated to Uplands Campus in March 2010.

International Student Program Objective

The International Student Program creates opportunities for students to develop long-lasting friendships with individuals and groups from cultural origins different from their own. This encourages the development of a global perspective. This supports the development of global networks and more peaceful and harmonious relations between countries and cultural groups.



Appendix 43 - Victor School



Description

Victor School is located at 2260 Victor Street, Victoria, BC, V8R 4C5. The school opened in 1966, purpose-built for students with special needs.

Over the years, Victor School has evolved into a learning centre for students, from Kindergarten to Grade 12, who are challenged physically and/or intellectually, and currently shares space with administrative and support staff for the district's Inclusive Learning department.

For the 2017-2018 school year, Victor School has two programs, hosting 15 students, with two full-time teachers and 11 educational assistants. The students are offered a wide variety of activities that take them into the community and enhance their learning experience.

During the summer of 2017, the Victor School playground was treated to an upgrade of the ground surface. The surface has made the playground a safe and fun place for our students and, after school hours, our community neighbours, to enjoy.





Appendix 44 - Victoria High School



School Description

The school is located at 1260 Grant Street in Victoria, British Columbia. The three-storey building with basement opened in 1914 with an addition completed in 1955. There was an additional 1,470 SM added in 2011 providing spaces for industrial education. The entire building is currently providing a total of 15,559 SM of floor area.

For 139 years Vic High has been a dominant educational influence in Victoria, and has provided interesting and challenging opportunities for its students. Vic High continues to offer a wide range of academic choices ranging from basic to honours levels in most academic subjects, and an extensive range of electives including technology, fine arts, home economics, career preparation and apprenticeship opportunities, as well as English as a Second Language courses and physical education. Renovations completed in 1979 and 1998 have enhanced and modernized the heritage structure. The addition in 2011 of the Fairey Technical wing gives Vic High the newest, most advanced Applied Tech centre in Greater Victoria.

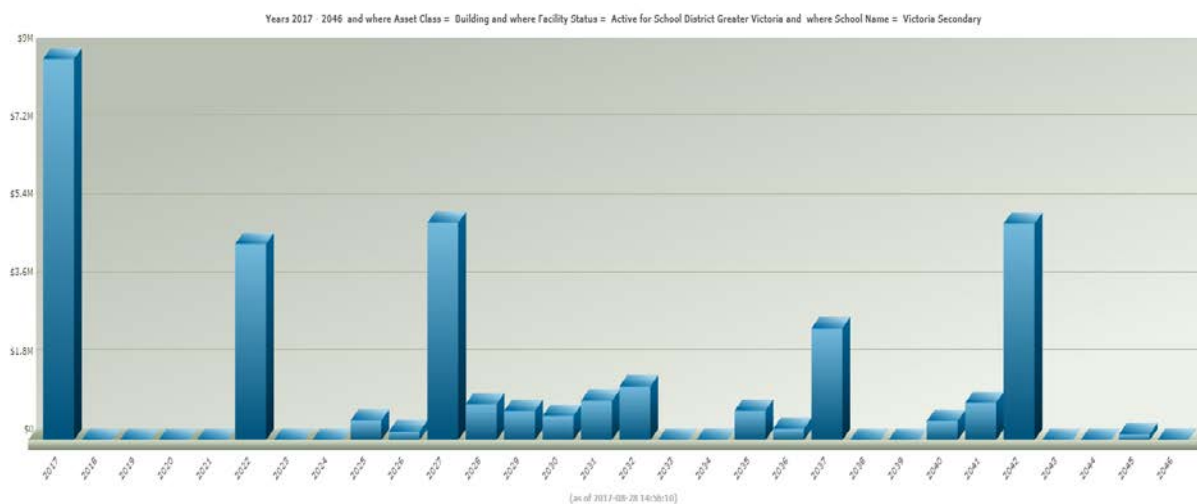

They are very excited about the growing integration of technology at their school which is enriching and enhancing student learning. All classrooms have Smartboards which both staff and students use.

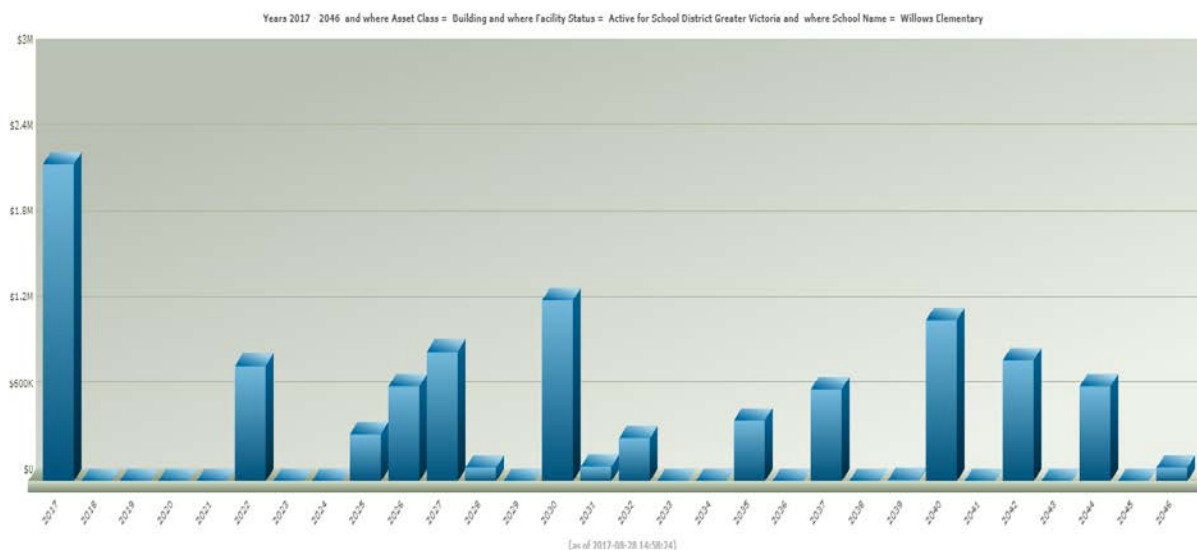
