### QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a School Trustee if they meet the following criteria:

- *Canadian Citizen;*
- *18 years of age or older on general voting day Saturday, October 20, 2018;*
- *resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and*
- *not disqualified under the School Act or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.*

### CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS and THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, for the 2018 general local election, the expense limit for candidates during the campaign period is \$68,534.70. In accordance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, for the 2018 general local elections, the third party advertising limit is \$3,426.74.
