The Greater Victoria School District provides public educational services to over 20,000 students in the Greater Victoria Area, encompassing six municipalities. To provide this service, the District has a current operating budget of \$184 million and employs approximately 3,000 staff; which includes, teachers, principals and vice-principals, support staff, psychologists, speech and language pathologists and exempt managerial staff.

The Speech-Language Pathologist provides a range of services: prevention, identification, assessment and direct intervention for students K-12 with communication challenges (high/low incidence), consultation with other educators regarding students' needs in the classroom and other environments, in-service training, and information sharing with families and other service providers.

This position supports students in acquiring communication skills central to academic achievement, as well as to foster social development and independent well-being.

Please Note: As this position is *itinerant*, the successful applicant must have a car and a valid BC driver's license.
