



# SCHOOL TECHNOLOGIST

## (TEMPORARY)

The Greater Victoria School District provides public educational services to over 20,000 students in the Greater Victoria Area, encompassing six municipalities. To provide this service, the District has a current operating budget of \$184 million and employs approximately 3,000 staff which includes teachers, principals and vice-principals, support staff, psychologists, speech and language pathologists and exempt managerial staff.

The Greater Victoria School District (SD61) is seeking a School Technologist. The successful candidate will be responsible for implementing and supporting technology in schools and will be working as part of a team of technologists led by a School Technologist Team Lead.

The successful candidate will:

- Install computer software, configure hardware systems, maintain current network configurations and troubleshoot technology problems on a variety of different platforms (primarily Windows, but may include Apple).
- Support the introduction of new educational technology.
- Work with school district staff to assist them in their use of technology.
- Have demonstrated experience and skill in presenting and training various stakeholders.

The successful candidate will have:
