



Q2 In which area of the Capital Region do you live? School District Boundary Map



Q3 Please indicate what grade level you are currently enrolled in.





Q4 Do you attend your current catchment school? Please use our School Locator Tool to determine your catchment school.





Q5 If you attend a school other than your catchment school, why? Select all that apply.





Q6 Are you enrolled in a Program of Choice? If yes, select which program(s) you are registered in. Select all that apply.





Q7 Are you enrolled in an Elementary School of Choice? If yes, select which school(s) apply.











Q12 Do you support the continued use of existing portables?







Q14 How important is access to the Program of Choice - French Immersion?





Q15 How important is access to Secondary Programs of Choice? This includes Sports Academies, Challenge and Flexible Studies.





Q16 How important is it that you attend school in your catchment area?




