I am writing on behalf of the Board of Education of School District No. 61 (Greater Victoria). I write with respect to the siting of the replacement of Crystal Pool. The Board views its positive relationship with the City of Victoria as very important to the success of our students and to the benefit of the broader community. As we both continue to grow we believe that working together will serve both of our organizations as well as our community. To this end, we would like to invite the City of Victoria to consider locating the new recreation facility at a School District site within the municipality, specifically Central Middle School.

We envision that multiple benefits could accrue to our students through access to the pool at the site. We also believe that the community would benefit by the creation of hub of complementary uses in a location that the community is already used to activity. While locating the community facility at a School District school would involve negotiation between the City and the Board and would be subject to public consultation, we believe that such discussions would be to our mutual benefit.
