We Have a Problem: Limited Space

- Increasing student enrolment
- One of the fastest growing school districts in the province this year.
 - 1,000 additional students in the past 4 years
- Restored collective agreement language that restricts students with diverse learning needs has impacted the availability of space in our schools






The Challenge

- Limited capital resources available (would involve land disposition)
- Goals is to balance all the needs of:
 - 47 different schools
 - 20,000+ students
 - Thousands of parents
 - Passionate and dedicated community members
- Ensure equitable access to amenities in all of our schools

The goal is to both refine plans based on our input and create as much certainty as soon as possible for announcement in June before implementation for the 2020 school year






Spring 2018 – Thetis Vale Consultation

The District engaged its community in the Thetis Vale area of the District to help address capacity issues.

While this consultation showed strong preferences in this specific community, it was clear that due to class size and composition requirements as well as increased enrolment, that the process needed to be broader.



Communities still have the opportunity to influence the outcome



Creating larger catchments for other schools to allow Cloverdale Traditional to maintain a District catchment	 Cloverdale remains as District wide catchment Impacts hundreds of families at all levels Walking distances become significant for many families Quadra will likely continue to experience capacity challenges 	



Alternative suggested	Considerations	We want your input
Creating an alternative registration priority that allows for students in schools with capacity issues to have priority at Cloverdale Traditional	 Cloverdale remains as District wide catchment Will require that many students will have to travel significant distances to access a school program Very little space at Cloverdale Would require a complex registration system 	





Relocating Cloverdale Traditional to another location	 The traditional program can continue Students from Macaulay may choose the traditional program at Lampson Lampson is not large enough to accommodate the current Cloverdale population Loss of revenue to the District Lampson may be required to open as a regular program school at some future point 	

Alternative suggested	Considerations	We want your input
Allowing three programs of choice in one catchment: Quadra French Immersion, Quadra English, and Cloverdale Traditional	 Cloverdale remains as District wide catchment Would require a complex registration system No guarantee that this would address the capacity challenges at Quadra


