

As a Doncaster parent of 2 children in French Immersion, 1 of whom is struggling academically, I am very concerned about this proposed change.

We have been considering the option of moving our struggling child into the English stream when he transitions to Cedar Hill in 1 year.

Our other child excels in school and may very well stay in the ~~eng~~ French stream during transition to Cedar Hill.

This causes hardship for our family if we end up with 1 child in Reynolds and one in Mt. Dong. In addition, the concerns of the English tract kids being separated from their entire cohort.

This is causing undue stress to families and children.


Please, Please Reconsider other options. The negative consequences on families and kids far outweigh the positives of creating "balanced" high school enrollments.

- With change for Quadra ^{English} Students from Phase 2 to Phase 3 _{to Vic High} does this make room for Doncaster English Students at Reynolds?
- French Immersion at Mt. Doug for Arbutus (and possibly Cedar Hill)?
- Cap Reynolds International Students approx. 30 less and move to Mt. Doug

Students who are attending (Doncaster) neighbourhood School in the Regular program should have priority over programs of choice.

I am extremely concerned that removing such a small group of students from their cohort and putting them in a new cohort that have been together at a very vulnerable time in their personal + educational development.

② I would really like the alternatives be examined closely to see if we can keep this small group of Doncaster English students with their cohort at Reynolds.

- international students ↑ at Mt. Day and ↓ at Reynolds
- moving programs of choice away from Mt. Day.
- putting French Immersion Artistic students at Mt. Day instead of Reynolds.

Please consider shifting the soccer program from Reynolds to Mt. Doug.
