Leslie Lee – former principal at George Jay Elementary spoke about the Student exclusion policy and the impact on students.

She also shared that it was important to represent the values and mission of district:

- Integrity
- Equity
- Respect
- Social Responsibility
- Transparency

Leslie shared with the committee that the committee should address the historical wrong publicly and rename to represent inclusion and diversity and the community. Racism discriminatory practices were and are still wrong.

Terri Smith – former George Jay Vice-Principal and Principal. Terri shared that she learned from Leslie Lee the racial implications that occurred and continue in society. Having George Jay name on school is not appropriate and it is important that we support those that didn't have a "good" experience.

Deanna Reid- Spoke with the committee on behalf of the George Jay community. Need to ensure equity and anti-racism. Deanna shared the concern that a name change will not change systemic racism if the only focus is on the name alone. Work needs to be done prior to considering a name change. Deanna shared some examples that are currently in place a George Jay:

- Equity and diversity group
- Anti-racism pro d day

She also urged the committee not to rush as this needs to be a thoughtful decision.
