BE A COURTEOUS RIDER:

Please review the following with your child:

- Be at your stop at least 5 minutes prior to your scheduled time.
- Respect and listen to the driver at all times.
- Respect other riders.
- Classroom conduct is to be observed on the bus, and any behavior causing distraction to driver or damage to bus will be reported to the Transportation Dept. and may result in loss of service.
- Students must not litter on bus or out window.
- Students must not extend any part of their body out of the windows or gesture at other drivers.
- Students must remain in their seat while the bus is in motion.
- When leaving the bus, do so in an orderly fashion (no pushing or shoving).
- No eating or drinking on the bus.
- Uttering threats and physical aggression towards others will result in immediate expulsion from bus.
