What are Safety Data Sheets?

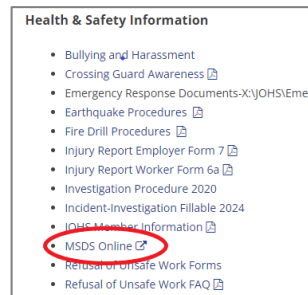
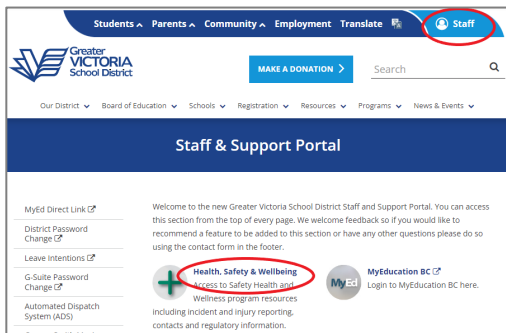
Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) are summary documents that provide information about the hazards of a product in more detail than the product's label. SDSs provide advice about safety precautions, including recommended safe handling, storage, protective equipment, and emergency measures associated with them. They are an important information resource for workplaces and workers.

If a product is covered by the Hazardous Products Act, it must have an SDS.

Within the Greater Victoria School District, workers can access SDSs through an online library available through MSDS Online.

Follow these three steps to access an SDS From MSDS Online:

1. Select the “Health, Safety & Wellbeing” module on the “Staff” section of the website:
2. Select the “MSDS Online” link:



3. Enter the product name or description in the search bar:
