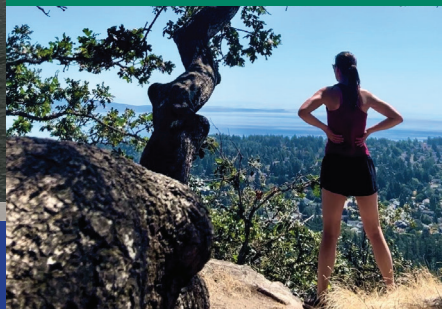

## About the Greater Victoria School District



We provide outstanding public education to over 20,000 students and employ over 3,000 staff members within the Greater Victoria Area (Esquimalt, Oak Bay, Victoria, View Royal, and a portion of Saanich and the Highlands).



The district spans approximately 50 sites including 28 elementary schools (grades K-5), 10 middle schools (grades 6-8), and 7 secondary schools (grades 9-12), as well as continuing studies and alternative education sites.

# Requirements to Teach in British Columbia

- 1 Have a valid unrestricted teaching certificate from another Canadian province or territory.
- 2 Meet the BC standards for fitness to teach as well as language proficiency requirements.
- 3 Submit an application, the cost of which is \$245 for Canadian Universities and \$395 for those outside of Canada. Processing can take a few weeks.

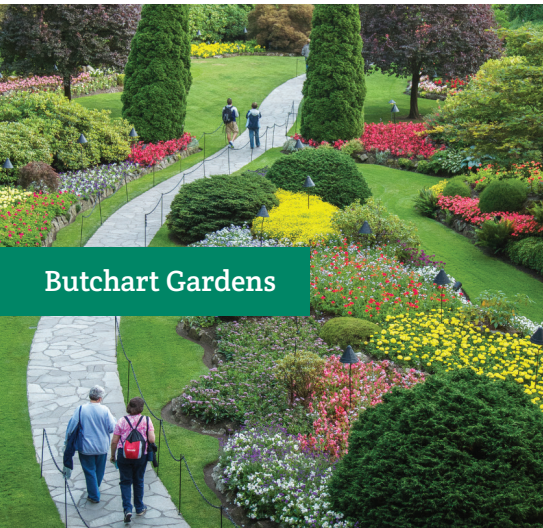
