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Transfer Decisions

When there are more students than a school can accommodate, transfers will be approved based on the following priorities:

- 1 re-enrolling students
- 2 catchment area sibling
- 3 catchment area student
- 3.5 non-catchment sibling impacted by a change to a catchment boundary
- 4 non-catchment area sibling
- 5 non-catchment area student
- 6 out of district student

Student enrolment priorities apply to all new registrations, transfer requests, elementary to middle and middle to secondary transitions, for English and French programs.

Transfer applications are reviewed based on the Student Enrolment Priorities and the availability of space at the desired school. When there are fewer spaces than the number of applicants a lottery will take place in accordance with the Student Enrolment Priorities. There is no advantage to being “first” to submit a transfer form.

In the event space is limited and a middle or secondary school cannot accept all non-catchment student requests, priority will be given to those non-catchment students already in the determined pathway of schools over other non-catchment, non-pathway students.

Please note: Parents/guardians accept responsibility for transportation of students who receive approval to attend a school outside their designated area.

SPORTS NOTE:

Transferring schools in Grades 9, 10, 11, or 12 may result in a student being INELIGIBLE for school sports teams, based on Provincial rules. Please ask a school administrator for clarification if you are hoping to play on a school team.
