- **Drama:** step into the world of theatre and build confidence through improvisation and performance-based activities.
- **Storytelling:** create original and imaginative written stories, exploring different genres, characters, and ways to share written work.
- **Sports & Games:** stay active while building teamwork and leadership skills through games, physical activities, and recreational sports.

# Middle School Two-Week Summer Program

## Eligibility

### Student Eligibility

Students must:

- Be currently enrolled in Grade 5, 6, or 7 (2025–2026 school year);
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or convention refugee;
- Have attended a Greater Victoria School District school during the 2025–2026 school year; and
- Commit to attending all program days.

### Tuition-Free Program

This summer program is tuition-free. All snacks, learning materials, and field trips are included at no cost. Please note that daily transportation to and from the program is not provided.

### Attendance Expectations

Daily attendance is essential. Please do not register unless you can commit to full attendance.

There are two key reasons for this policy:

1. The fast pace of summer programming makes it difficult to catch up on missed learning.
2. The Ministry of Education and Child Care only provides funding for students who attend from the start.

Registering and then missing classes may also take away a valuable spot from another student.

There are limited spaces and they will fill up fast! Registration opens Monday, April 27.
